We will have riders and horses to assist in the orientation. There will also be refreshments to enjoy.

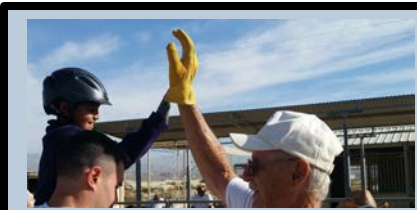
